WHAT DOES IT FIND?

- Generally, word cards, either digital or paper, readymade or self-constructed, can be effective for vocabulary learning.
- Paper word cards can be more effective than digital word cards.
- Ready-made word cards can be more effective than self-structured word cards.
- Word cards are better used for intentional vocabulary learning than incidental vocabulary learning.
- Word cards are more popular with learners at higher levels of proficiency.
- When learners are introduced to new words, mass learning can be more effective because it will result in a large number of repeated encounters with the words. Mass learning can then be followed with spaced learning.
