WHAT DOES IT FIND?

- Using MOOCs for language learning can entail some limitations e.g., less enjoyable or productive activities, limited oral production opportunities
- xMOOC model is better for beginners, while cMOOCs - which can engage learners in peer-to-peer communication – is more suitable for advanced learners

HOW CAN I USE THE FINDINGS IN MY TEACHING?

- To design a successful MOOC, course designers and teachers should encourage social learning since it can motivate learners and provide more engagement
- Teachers' presence can have a positive influence on MOOC completion
- Teachers should encourage learners' participation from the beginning of the MOOC
- Teachers should build a community of learners to provide more authentic interactional space for learners which complements the MOOC



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
